- Developing a new custom assessment tracking tool that allows districts to easily store assessment data within our system.
- Creating a more relevant homepage for superintendents that provides them with smaller, more digestible data insights that help them make data-driven decisions.

You will collaborate closely with stakeholders to brainstorm, sketch, and iterate on new ideas, as well as work with internal teams to bring these concepts to life. This hands-on approach ensures that our products continually evolve to meet the needs of our users, providing them with the most valuable and actionable information.
